ROSH HASHANA 2022

ראש השנה 5783

Less than a week ago, we entered into a New Year on Rosh Hashana which began this September 25th to September 27th. We have officially entered in to the year 5783 according to the Jewish Calendar. There are many meanings around this new year 5783, here are some excerpts from different sources that talk about this new year we are in.

The year 5783 stands for:

- ◆ According to Joel 2:18-27, the latter rain outpouring begins not with the worldwide outpouring of God's Spirit, but with financial provision. Joel 2:18, 19, 23, 24, and 26 are extremely specific about this. These verses all discuss the restoration and outpouring of grain, new wine and oil to God's people. "Grain" is financial provision; "new wine" is the Holy Spirit's restoring and refreshing work inside the heart, mind, will and emotions; and "oil" is His anointing to minister to others. God's work begins with the restoration of all things to His beloved children, and continues with using His newly-refreshed children to minister to others, bringing new sons and daughters out of the world and into His sheep-fold.
- ◆ Luke 1:37 and Luke 1:45 are key verses for this Hebrew year. Luke 1:37 says: "For with God nothing will be impossible" (Luke 1:37, NKJV). And Luke 1:45 says this: "Blessed is she who believed, for there will be a fulfillment of those things which were told her from the Lord" (Luke 1:45, NKJV).
- ◆ In this Hebrew year, things which were impossible in the natural shall be manifest supernaturally. The transition of "seemingly impossible" to "suddenly possible" will be a hallmark of the year.
- ◆ Watch and listen for the simplest strategies as Holy Spirit whispers them in your ear. His still, small voice will open a way for you to do things this year that previously would have taken you five to 10 years to accomplish in your flesh.

- ◆ Suddenly you will see it; suddenly the vengeance of God will spring forth on your behalf. I am hearing the Spirit say “whiplash” to illustrate this; when He comes with His fury on your behalf, you will look at the results of what He has done, then look back upon what was, and it will happen so fast that you will be in awe, with proverbial “whiplash,” at what His mighty arm has accomplished on your behalf.
- ◆ It will be a year of humbling ourselves to seek God with continued fervor. The lower we go to humble ourselves before Him, the higher He can lift us up. Humble yourself this year more than you ever have before. Pursue humility and pray to become more humble than you ever have been before. You will be glad you did.
- ◆ As we step into 5783, the year of Retribution, we’re going to see a giving out of blessings and curses. This will be a time where God makes things right. Those who have continued to seek Him despite their circumstances will be openly rewarded. On the flip side of this, God will continue to release His justice.
- ◆ One of the other meanings is stability. As God deals with the things that are false, He’s balancing the scales and releasing stability throughout the land.

WHAT TYPE OF INTERCESSOR ARE YOU?

In September we had an awesome workshop weekend with Casey and Esther Brost from Edmonton. Casey has been an integral part of our intercession team for Battle for Canada over the last 4 years. Esther is an active member of the Alberta Dance Team and has been with us at each Battle as part of the worship and dance teams.

The focus of the weekend was Intercession and Dance and how they not only work in tandem with each other but how both are needed in this season that we are entering into.

Here at the Harvest we believe that intercession and prayer is the power that sustains the call of God on our ministry. We are also worshippers at our core and believe that we are in a season where the worshippers are

being called forward to go ahead of the armies of God to secure the victory in the battle that we are engaged in.

A lot of people tend to label themselves "intercessors", but in truth many of us carry this mantle/mandate of intercession even when we don't fully understand it.

Casey presented a list of different types of intercessors which really brought some clarification to the different types of intercession that some of you may be called to or already walk in.

Here is a list that might bring some clarity to some of the passions of your heart in intercession.

Transformational Intercessors – These intercessors intercede prophetically, asking the Lord what is needed for a city, a church, a business, or a region to bring kingdom change – or "transformation." Most often, this involves repentance but also can include warfare, prophetic acts, and dance intercession. It involves finding what has defiled the land by inquiring of the Lord, often confirming through historical facts and present reality.

Political Intercessors – These have a healthy burden for things in the political arena that need change and for nations, cities, or the world.

Crisis Intercessors – These intercede for crises, emergencies and immediate needs like 9/11, Japan's 3/11 Tsunami, COVID-19, Amber Alerts, or an ambulance with someone on the side of the road. This specialty in intercession often includes interceding to prevent or stop weather situations and natural disasters in order to decrease and stop loss of life and property.

Personal Intercessors – These intercessors are called and sometimes appointed to intercede for pastors and leaders in a personal way as a specific assignment.

Administrative Intercessors – These intercessors find it easy to establish prayer chains, 24 hour prayer watches, times of fasting; and to assemble people to intercede in a crisis, etc. These intercessors are sometimes the scribes for an intercession group.

Birthing or Midwife Intercessors – These intercessors love to "birth" souls, revival, new ministries, schools, and Godly businesses. This may involve travailing, which is a type of birthing intercession. Midwife intercessors sometimes help the travailing intercessor to birth what Holy Spirit is wanting to birth.

Prophetic Acts Intercessors – These are Ezekiel and Jeremiah type intercessors that act out what the Lord tells them to do with specific prophetic acts to achieve God's purpose.

Dance Intercessors and Worship Warriors – These intercessors intercede through dance and warring in worship. This type of dance includes prophetic acts and gestures ("He teaches my hands to war" Ps 144:1), and sometimes a warring dance. This can include banners, flags, hoops, tambourines, streamers, baskets, etc. Why does this and all prophetic acts work so well? Because it is by faith and all the glory has to go to God and not yourself.

Compassion and Mercy Intercessors – These feel compassion for others, especially for the lost. They feel other's needs and hurts. They intercede for certain people groups out of compassion (such as for the elderly, children, students, foster kids, babies, the sexually exploited, certain races or the ill), often feeling their hurts.

Warfare Intercessors – These intercessors are typically involved in high-level spiritual warfare, binding and loosing. They follow the Lord, battling against His enemies, and are familiar with demonic hierarchies (principalities and powers and rulers of the darkness for instance) and how things work in the spirit realm.

Issues Intercessors – These intercessors see a need and seek to solve it (not just emergencies). This might include the state of the Church, sex-trafficking, homelessness, abortion, etc.

Issachar Intercessors – These intercessors feel a burden for times and seasons, or the future. They see what is to come and intercede regarding that. They hear from the Lord about times and seasons and may be seers in this realm (1 Chron 12:32). This often includes intercession about the end-times, for Jesus' return, for the Bride of Christ to be ready and spotless, or for new wineskins and changes in the Church.

Missions Intercessors – These awesome intercessors are burdened for the needs and issues of missions and missionaries around the world. This is such a much-needed job as most intercessors do not intercede for missions far away but concentrate on their own area and church. Missions intercessors intercede for such things as the mission's protection and finances, but most of all for souls (Matt 9:38). This includes interceding for the persecuted church which is not often included in intercession groups as well.

Intercessors for Israel – All should intercede for Israel, but some have a specific burden for Israel and the Jewish people (Ezek 33).

Marketplace Intercessors – These intercessors are called and often appointed to intercede for certain businesses. Some may intercede for a certain industry or marketplace sector, but others may intercede for a specific business. Example: Joseph in Egypt.

“HISTORY BELONGS TO THE INTERCESSOR”



Here is an excerpt from the blog of our Israel friend and partner, Steve Carpenter. This story gives another example of biblical intercession for a whole city. You can read the whole exhortation on highway19ministries.org

In the days of Lot, God wanted Abraham to know what He was doing.

Genesis 18:17-18, 20-22, *“And the Lord said, ‘Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, 18 since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?’” 20 And the Lord said, “Because the outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grave, 21 I will go down now and see whether they have done altogether according to the outcry against it that has come to Me; and if not, I will know.” 22 Then the men turned away from there and went toward Sodom, but Abraham still stood before the Lord.”*

As Abraham stood still before the Lord, his heart was being stirred to make intercession on behalf of the righteous remnant living in the midst of such corruption. He appealed to the Lord with questions regarding His mercy and justice. For ten verses, Abraham conversed with the Almighty, stood in the gap on behalf of a righteous remnant, and made intercession before the Judge of all the Earth.

He said, *“Would You also destroy the righteous with the wicked? 24 Suppose there were fifty righteous within the city; would You also destroy the place and not spare it for the fifty righteous that were in it? 25 Far be it from You to do such a thing as this, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous should be as the wicked; far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?” 26 So the Lord said, “If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes.” 27 Then Abraham answered and said, “Indeed now, I who am but dust and ashes have taken it upon myself to speak to the Lord: 28 Suppose there were five less than the fifty righteous; would You destroy all of the city for lack of five?” So He said, “If I find there forty-five, I will not destroy it.” 29 And he spoke to Him yet again and said, “Suppose there should be forty found there?” So He said, “I will not do it for the sake of forty.” 30 Then he said, “Let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak: Suppose thirty should be found there?” So He said, “I will not do it if I find thirty there.” 31 And he said, “Indeed now, I have taken it upon myself to speak to the Lord: Suppose twenty should be found there?” So He said, “I will not destroy it for the sake of twenty.” 32 Then he said, “Let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak but once more: Suppose ten should be found there?” And He said, “I will not destroy it for the sake of ten.” 33 So the Lord went His way as soon as He had finished speaking with Abraham; and Abraham returned to his place.”*


The beautiful thing here is that even in the midst of pending judgement coming upon Sodom and Gomorrah, God is responding, in real-time, to the courageous intercessions of His friend, Abraham.

I love the interaction between God and Abraham in this scene. Abraham, without intervening with God's justice, was appealing to God's mercy as he interceded for the righteous remnant. This is a delicate tension to keep, and I think that Abraham nailed it.

So what can we take away from these verses about the “days of Noah” and the “days of Lot”? Perhaps we can focus less on the corruption and darkness that surrounds us and focus more on what we are to be building and how we ought to be praying in this critical hour in human history.





Paul had at least three purposes in mind when he wrote Thessalonians. He wanted to encourage the Christians in Thessalonica who were making good progress in their new faith. He desired to correct misinformation about himself and his fellow missionaries that some of his critics in Thessalonica were circulating.

And, he wrote to give additional instruction that would contribute to the Thessalonians' spiritual growth.

Paul wrote 2 Thessalonians to commend his children in the faith for their growth and faithfulness, to correct the doctrinal error about the day of the Lord, and to warn the idle to get back to work.
